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Information Booth Vendor Policies

- All Information Booth Vendors must register and sign the Information Booth Policy & Procedure Agreement by Friday, October 13, 2023 in order to participate in Stockton Hmong New Year.
- 2. Information Booth availability will be on a first come, first serve basis with no exceptions.
- 3. All Information Booth Vendors must submit an application with full payment no later than Friday, October 13, 2023. A vendor who failed to make a full payment by this deadline will lose the booth(s) and the booth(s) will be available to the next vendor in line. The booth fee is nonrefundable. If you made the payment and you decided not to set up your booth, you will lose your payment fee.
- 4. Each *Private Business/Profit-Organization* or *Non-Profit Organization* can only bring **two (2)** people per allotted space of 10ft x10ft without paying the day entrance fee. Each Private Business/Profit- Organization or Non-Profit Organization who wishes to bring more than 2 individuals will have to pay the entrance fee in advance.
- 5. School Clubs will get a free information booth, but they will have to pay the day entrance fee and bring their own tables and chairs.
- 6. Information Booth Vendors will only be allowed to enter the event with badge(s) issued by Lao Family. We will not allow anyone without badge to enter the gates on Saturday and Sunday morning. If you are unable to pick up your badge on Friday at the Fairgrounds, then pick up your badge on Saturday morning, November 11, 2023 between the hours of 6:00 am. –7:45 am.
 - **Vendors will be charged \$10.00 to replace a lost badge**. You must wear your badge at all times during the event. It will give you the privilege of re-entering the gate during closed hours if you have to leave for any reason.
- 7. The Vendor Gate will be opened during the hours of 6 AM 8 AM on Saturday, November 11, 2023 through Sunday, November 12, 2023. After 7:45 AM, all Information Booth Vendors must move their car outside of the gated area to the designated parking lot.
- 8. No vehicle or trailer will be allowed inside the event unless vendor cannot operate without the trailer, whereas equipment/supplies are in the trailer/vehicle.
- 9. Information Booth Vendors must station at their booth or space and will be not permitted to relocate and/or extend beyond their assigned space without authorization from the Information Booth Coordinator.
- 10. Information Booth Vendors can **ONLY** pass out information regarding their service to the community. **School Clubs** can **ONLY** sell flowers, balloons, and candies at their booth.



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- 11. Information Booth Vendors will be responsible for cleaning up, maintaining, and sanitizing the area around and within their assigned booth throughout the New Year.
- 12. All Information Booth Vendors are liable for their own personal belonging and property. Stockton Hmong New Year will not be liable for any loss or damage to vendor's properties or belonging during the event.
- 13. Violation of any of the terms or conditions of this agreement, in part or in whole, will subject the vendor to appropriate sanction by the proper authorities. Additionally, any such violation shall be a breach of this agreement and subject the vendor to termination and removal from the event at the sole discretion of the Stockton Hmong New Year.
